

Alta Vista Veterinary Clinic Boarding Policy

1. All pets must have proof of current vaccinations. For dogs this includes DHPP, BOARDETELLA, FLU, AND RABIES. For cats this includes: Leukemia and Aids Test, FVCRP, LEUKEMIA, BORDETELLA, AND RABIES. If proof is unavailable, the vaccines will be administered by Alta Vista Veterinary Clinic at the owner's expense. INITIAL _____

2. An emergency contact phone number must be left as well as additional instructions of whom to contact if the first party is unavailable. If these parties are unable to be contacted, the handling of any medical emergency/treatment will be left to the veterinarian's discretion, and any additional costs will be added to your invoice. INITIAL _____

3. For the concern and welfare of your pet, a routine examination at Alta Vista Veterinary Clinic will be given to any pet that has not had one within the last year. If a pet is exhibiting symptoms of illness or needs any vaccines or testing, a physical exam will be given regardless of the last exam date. INITIAL _____

4. Alta Vista Veterinary Clinic is not responsible for any pet becoming sick while boarding. Any pet becoming ill while in our care will be treated at the owner's expense unless signed, and written instructions are provided on how medical emergencies are to be handled, (including financial limits). INITIAL _____

5. Alta Vista Veterinary Clinic is not responsible for any pet becoming exposed to fleas. Pets may be bathed while boarding for an additional fee and will be given a Capstar tablet to make sure they do not leave with fleas. If pet's come in with fleas they will be given a Capstar when they arrive and when they leave. We can also treat them with a single dose of advantage at the client's request. INITIAL _____

6. Any pets requiring additional medical care, (medication administration, wound treatment, etc.) will be charged additional fees in addition to boarding fee. INITIAL _____

7. Pets that are sick, vicious or under six weeks of age cannot be boarded without previous approval from Dr. Budde. Additional fees may be added to the boarding charge once approval is granted. INITIAL _____

8. Exotic animals are not to be boarded at Alta Vista Veterinary Clinic unless approved by Dr. Budde. INITIAL _____

9. Alta Vista Veterinary Clinic is not responsible for any misplaced or damaged personal property left. Please take your leashes and collars, and carriers with you. We will provide and use our own blankets, bowls, leashes and temporary collars. INITIAL _____

10. To the beset of my knowledge my pet has not been sick within the last 10 days and is presently in a good state of health. INITIAL _____
